

TOWARDS A RESPONSIBLE INDIAN MICA SUPPLY CHAIN

MICA IS A GROUP OF MINERALS THAT IS USED IN A LARGE VARIETY OF CONSUMER GOODS AND INDUSTRY MATERIALS

Thanks to its large range of functions, mica can be used as a pearlescent pigment for car paint and cosmetics, a component of small electrical households and cables or a functional filler in construction materials, rubbers and oil-drilling fluids.





THE DISTRICTS OF BIHAR AND JHARKHAND IN INDIA REPRESENT ONE OF THE WORLD'S LARGEST SOURCE OF MICA, MAINLY COLLECTED INFORMALLY BY LOCAL FAMILIES

India is one of the largest producer of mica, mainly collected from the top soil by local communities, using simple hand tools. A majority of this informal collection is located in the North-eastern districts of Bihar and Jharkhand. Because of the remoteness and lack of vital resources of this area, local populations strongly rely on mica collection to maintain a livelihood.
